DR Congo

- Praise God that on Sunday, October 31, the Evangelical Mennonite Church of the Congo (CEM) held a special worship service to dedicate to the Lord a property (land) purchased with funds provided by AIMM for the construction of the church building of the Nouvelle Vision local church (New Vision). In his sermon, Pastor Jean-Felix Cimbalanga thanked God and AIMM for the property. He stressed that the church to be built on the property should be a place of peace, worship, praise, and prayer. At the end of the service all CEM pastors and church members raised their voices to express gratitude to the Lord and say thank you to AIMM for this gift of the property.



- Pray for the CMCo transitional executive team as they lead the church. Pray that God will provide them with wisdom and discernment in the preparation of the general assembly that will appoint new executive officers.
- Pray for CEM's saving and loan project that has been affected by COVID-19 and the economic situation, making it difficult for members to reimburse loans.
