Angola

Pray God's provision and blessing during this summer's growing season so that farmers will gain maximum benefit from this assistance. Pray also for success in obtaining visas for facilitators who will travel from the DR Congo to support the project with technical and organizational assistance.
- Thank God for the ministry of Pastor Sabastiao Makanipovi, General Secretary and Bishop of the Evangelical Mennonite Church in Angola, in the Lunda Norte province, which borders the DR Congo. A number of congregations there are making decisions about the future of their witness. Pray for guidance and clarity as they move forward in faith.

Burkina Faso

Last month the church sent Yaya Bengaly and his family as its first international missionary witness to live and work among the Jalonké people around Faléa, Mali.
